Melrose High School will be hosting a Disability Awareness and Careers Workshop on Wednesday 11 October 2017, 9.00am to 12.30pm approx., in the School Library.

This workshop is for students in Years 9 and 10.

The Commonwealth Government has provided funding for the National Disability Services projectABLE team to provide workshops for senior students about disability awareness and careers in the sector.

This is a **FREE** half-day fun and interactive workshop, conducted by a team of people with lived experience of disability. During the session, students are encouraged to participate in activities, ask questions and discuss myths associated with disability.

It has been estimated that the number of jobs in the disability sector will double as the NDIS funding system matures. The focus on individual choice and control by people with disabilities will result in an increase in the number of jobs in a broader range of professions.

Participants will be limited to 40 students.
